Sewing machine, cleaned and oiled in good working order with appropriate electrical cords and multi-plug.

Machine feet for straight sewing, 1/4" foot

Optional: feet for specialist sewing such as open-toed embroidery foot

Needles: appropriate needles for the weight threads and fabric you bring.

Thread: selection of neutral and matching threads for piecing and applique

Optional: selection of specialty threads such as metallic and embroidery threads

rotary cutter with sharp blade, cutting board and rulers of your choice.

Optional: hand sewing tools: a variety of needles, embroidery threads and sharp scissors.

Stabilizer of your choice

Optional: fusible of your choice

Marking tools for fabric and paper

Notebook

Images or written material meaningful to you that might inform your work.

Fabric

This is the exciting part: You are making a piece about YOU. So bring a variety of fabrics in colors of your choice, making sure you include a good range of values and contrasts to help you create the magic. Include cottons, hand-dyes, commercial prints, checks and plaids, stripes and prints in different scales. You may want to include silks, velvets, brocades and other specialty fabrics.

Preparation

Spend time thinking about what you might want to include in your quilt. However you are NOT required to have planned it all before you get to class! That is what the class is for. Think instead about symbols or motifs, colors etc you may possibly wish to use so you come with a rich selection to use as a jumping off point.
