SUPPLY LIST (Please label your supplies)

Long milliners, basting or doll needles for hand sewing (3" is good, but it's your choice Thimble, scissors, seam ripper, Quilter's marking pencil (or graphite),

Rubber gloves (flexible gloves to wear when dyeing and removing stitches).

Old clothes to wear, apron.

Spray bottle

Pins (to pin into your design board); pin cushion.

One/half yard white Prepared to Dye cotton, washed and air dried (I like to use cotton sateen, but other cotton is fine).

One piece of clothing if you want to try embellishing clothing, If you bring a t or other knitted rather than woven cloth, bring a ball needle

Plastic to wrap your pieces in for batching (dry cleaner bags are great),

Sketch book, pencil, eraser, black marker.

Several paint brushes for painting on dyes,

Additional fabric if you want to work larger/faster

Optional:

Strong thread or cord for hand stitching, e.g. dental floss, hand quilting thread, buttonhole twist

Mask and dyers gloves (only needed if you would like to help with mixing dyes) Garden gloves, quilter's gloves with grippers or hand sewers gloves (if you have them) can be helpful in pulling up threads.

Zip lock plastic bag for transporting wet fabric home.

Embroidery floss, additional needles, batting and backing if you would like to start embellishing one of your shibori pieces.

Mirror or framed picture with glass (no actual picture is necessary) Task lamp.
