

Student Materials:

A variety of cloth, cotton & silk broadcloth recommended. Please bring white and light solid colors-only. Cloth should be pre-cut into small sizes: fat quarter & fat-eighths are ideal

A variety of papers: hot-press watercolor paper, hand-made paper, new and used coffee filters, recycled magazine pages, and even junk mail!

A small selection of transparent paints, if you have them. I recommend Setacolor, Golden High Flow Transparent acrylics, acrylic inks.

Several dropcloths for work table

large stack of used newspapers or blank newsprint. (think the equivalent of 4 Sunday papers). The old papers will be used to remove wax with an iron.

Students within driving range may wish to bring a plastic bucket, which can be used to haul wet items.

2-4 large Ziploc or plastic bags for wet storage.

paper or plastic (small) grocery bag for trash.

2-4 kitchen sized trash can liners.

Paper and cloth scissors

Sketchbook and pen/pencil for taking notes.

Students must wear clothing suitable for messy painting and closed-toe shoes are mandatory.
