

Patch of Blue Supply List

- **Fabric:**
 - [2 yds. PFD white cotton](#) ---quartered
 - 1 yd. Muslin
 - Bag of scraps
 - Clothing to cut up
 - Crib size all cotton batting
 - Optional—a packet of blue indigo quilt charms (usually around 5” square with many designs)
 - Cotton scarf (or bring one of your own/or make one)
 - This one works well—from Dharma--CS15 - Cotton Gauze Scarves - 15" X 60"
 - Not a knit or stretchy scarf
 - Or bring a piece of muslin cut to 15” x 68”
- **Dye Materials:**
 - Indigo Blue fiber reactive dye—8 oz.
 - 1 lb. soda ash fixer
 - 2 oz. fiber reactive dye—2 or 3 other colors
 - Urea—5 lbs.
 - Soda Ash—5 lbs.
- **Dye Tools**
 - Mesh laundry bag—med. Size
 - Plastic kitchen strainer
 - 4—5 quart size containers
 - 4—5 cup containers
 - Mixing tools
 - Small bucket
 - Rubber gloves
 - Apron
 - 2 large size peanut butter type jars with lids
 - 2 yd. plastic drop cloth or shower curtain liner—cut into 1 yd. lengths
 - Paper towels/clean up rag
 - 2-- 2-cup plastic measuring cups
 - Clamps, clips, rubber bands, Lego toys for resist techniques
 - Tablespoon measuring spoon
 - Optional--Tiny clips available at [Amazon](#)
 - Stamping tools/surface design tools
 - Hardware tool—rubber base with handle (used as a spreader)
 - Scraper tool with gridded teeth
- **Hand stitching materials**
 - [Pearl cotton](#)
 - in a thickness you prefer

- make sure you have a few shades of blue—variegated is fun
- I like size 8 & 12
- use what you prefer
- Valdani brand is lovely to work with—variegated would be my recommendation
- 2--3 skeins of pearl cotton (not embroidery floss)
- Larger eye--needs that fit the thread—chenille needles work well
- Needle threader tool (optional)
- Thimble—leather ones with a metal insert work well (optional)
- Straight pins
