Student materials

Materials fee: \$25.00

- Glue stick and a repositionable adhesive roller-(can get at Jo Anns, office supply stores, Michaels)
- Hot glue gun/glue (this can be shared between several people)DO NOT purchase if you do not already have one.
- Scissors-to cut fabric and paper. You might want a very small pair for fine cutting
- Exacto knife for cutting cardboard
- Cutting mat-small - or a heavy piece of cardboard-(DO NOT purchase mat if you don't have one)
- Pencils: regular and at least one 6B or softer drawing pencil
- Sharpies--ultra fine point and larger--black
- Sketchbook - **at least** 9" x 12"
- Tracing paper
- Fabric, colorful magazine pages, and/or other interesting things for collage (fabric may be small scraps)
- Small artist paintbrush--we will use for India ink and paint
- Several 1" foam brushes
- 4oz tube white acrylic paint (inexpensive) This could be shared between two people
- 8" x 11" printouts of three different paintings, drawings, prints or photographs that speak to you.
- Images/objects that you might want to use as inspiration
- Fusible web-you do not need much, about 1 yard or less.
- OPTIONAL: stamps/carved lino blocks, pipe cleaners, stickers, textures for background rubbings, any mark making tools you like, metallic paints, pencils and color markers, collections of small objects to attach to collage, ruler, felt

To help you decide what optional items to bring, the following materials will be available for class use and are covered by the materials fee.

- Cardboard-old cereal boxes and corrugated cardboard
- India ink
- Mylar
- Spray adhesive
- Color pencils and pastels
- Acrylic medium
- Colored tissue papers
- Black construction paper
- White copy paper
- More assorted stuff
