

## **Lisa Binkley's 5-Day Class: Hand Stitched Treasure(d) Boxes**

### KIT CONTENTS & CLASSROOM SUPPLIES PROVIDED:

- Wood cigar box (approx. 8" w x 8.5" h x 2" d)
- Sandpaper
- Foam core
- 2 pieces of fusible Peltex (one for box and one for lid)
- E6000 adhesive
- Color booklet of stitch techniques, photos, design, materials, and construction suggestions
- CLASSROOM SUPPLIES:
  - Acrylic paints and matte medium
  - Small cups for mixing and holding paints

### SUPPLY LIST:

#### Required Supplies:

- A pair of small, sharp scissors
- A chalk pencil or other tool for making removable marks on fabric
- A pen or pencil for note-taking
- A small (e.g. 6" x 6") sketch pad with a few colored pencils or markers
- A bead cloth for holding beads while stitching
- At least two pieces of fabric, at least 9" x 9" each (for embroidered panels in box and lid)
- 1-2 small paint brush(es), about 1/2" or narrower
- At least one spool of beading thread (size D), in a neutral or coordinating color
- #10 beading needles (at least 2)
- #12 beading needles if using #13 or smaller beads
- A mix of beads (seed beads, bugle beads, novelty beads) that appeal to you
- A mix of embroidery floss and threads that appeal to you
- Embroidery needles that work with your threads (e.g., #7 and #22)
- Embellishments, charms, small sculptures or found objects that you would like to incorporate into your piece
- A poem, phrase, word, or text you would like to incorporate into your piece

#### Optional Supplies:

- Small, portable task lamp
- 1-2 pieces of thin quilt batting, at least 8" x 8" each
- Thread wax
- Needle threader
- Thimble (if you like to use one)
- A bead scoop for picking up beads
