

## ***Supply list for Paint, Stitch, Create Quilts***

- 1 or 2 canvas pads or primed canvas
- Sewing machine (optional)
- Basic sewing supplies
- Yard of duck cloth
- Paper & fabric scissors
- Hand thread if you prefer that to machine stitching
- Fabric scraps or a few related fat quarters
- Three colors fluid acrylic paint—red family, blue family, yellow family (I recommend Golden Fluid Acrylics)
- One each of a smaller size black & white fluid acrylic paint
- 2 translucent colors that respond to the other colors chosen
- Paint brushes—a variety
- Acrylic gel medium
- Paint palette
- Little containers to store mixed paint
- Mixed media paper pad
- Lightweight tissue type papers (old wrapping stuff, old sewing patterns....)
- Old newspapers, magazine images....
- Found objects such as rusty bottle tops, textured paper, ephemera
- Basic paint supplies such as containers, apron, texture tools
- A few rags or paper towels
- Latex gloves—small box
- 10—20 substrates (painting surfaces); any of these can work:
  - Stretched canvas/plain canvas
  - Hardwood that has a smooth surface
  - Small Masonite pieces
  - Heavy paper such as watercolor, Bristol...
- Student work for show and tell—the real thing or jpg's
- Note taking material

--If you work really fast, bring more supplies.
