

Supply List for Hidden Worlds: Miniature Books with a Box

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- scissors for cutting paper or fabric
- pencil and eraser
- 12" metal ruler
- fabric scraps for covering and embellishing books
- an old book from which to make a box (no bigger than approx. 7"x9")
- a few of your favorite drawing materials such as markers, colored pencils, or drawing pens
- magazines and other fun papers for collage and embellishing your books
- 8oz bottle of PVA glue
- plastic container for glue (yogurt cups are great)
- inexpensive brushes for applying glue (1.5"-2" for box, and several smaller for details and small books)
- gridded self-healing cutting mat
- #11 xacto knife with approx. 5-10 extra blades
- utility knife with extra blades (I like Olfa snap-off blade utility knife)
- bone folder
- light duty awl
- super glue control gel
- Chartpak ad marker colorless blender
- 8oz matte medium
- 1 roll waxed paper
- 1 pack baby wipes

Optional: Bring images and photographs that you love (for adding content to your books), color and black and white copies (laser printer or laser photo copier only) for image transfers (be sure that any text you want to use is printed backwards in order to transfer forwards), found papers, small found objects, buttons, beads, old embroidered linens, pretty threads, stamp pads, stamps, or anything else you may think of to add to your books and box.
