

Translating Your Story into Fabric

Supplies Participants Should Bring:

- A sketchpad, pencil, eraser, and fine tip black marker.
- 10 - 20 yards of paper backed Wonder-Under (#805) fusible web. Please DO NOT BRING HEAT 'N BOND or STEAM A SEAM.
- Fabrics for the quilt:
 - Bring washed batik or hand-dyed fabrics. These fabrics work best in raw edge fusing. (Printed fabrics will show a white line around the raw edge of the fabric.)
 - Bring a variety of colors and values that relate to your quilt idea.
 - Bring enough fabric to create a quilt measuring, at maximum, 50" x 50".
 - DO NOT BRING FABRIC WITH A PERMANENT PRESS FINISH.
 - I will have hand-dyed fabrics and threads for sale on Bazaar Night.
- Parchment paper, a roll for pattern transfer.
- Sharp fabric scissors 8" and 5".
- Paper scissors.
- Rotary cutter, ruler, mat and specialty blades, such as Pinking, Wavy, or Scallop.
- Black fine point Sharpie marker.
- Batting twin size or larger. (Suggested is Hobbs Heirloom Premium Batting 80% cotton, 20% Polyester.)
- 2 – 3 yards of quilt backing fabric.
- Iron and ironing surface (minimum of 18" wide) May be shared with other class members.
- Thimble for hand stitching (optional).
- Tweezers (optional).
- Sewing machine (Optional. It depends on how quickly you work).
- Thread for machine work if you're bringing one.

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
