Student Supplies Needed:

Cloth: all pieces from 8" up to fat quarter sized

<u>cotton cloth</u>-from sheer (cheesecloth) to cotton broadcloth in white to light solids*
<u>silk</u>-choose a variety from sheer (organza and chiffon) to broadcloth in white to light solids*

*Bring several dozen pieces of as many types of cloth as you can. This will give you many opportunities for experimentation!

Paper: in sizes from 4x6" to 12x12

pad or package of mixed media, acrylic, and/or watercolor paper, minimum 12 sheets. Look for paper that is between 90lb and 140lb in sizes from 4x6" to 12x12. Look for paper that is between 90lb and 140lb. You may wish to order larger sheets of paper and cut them to smaller sizes at home. Smooth (hot press)paper works best. Optional: white tissue paper.

Bring whatever packs easily but bring as much as you can pack so you aren't limited in your experiments! You can find papers at local art stores, Michaels, and places like Blick Art Supply http://tinyurl.com/jmh669u or Jerry's Artorama http://tinyurl.com/gsr9fpl

Paint: We will work with a variety of acrylic (water-based) paints in this workshop. Instructor will provide paint for classroom use. Students are encouraged to bring their own paints if it is possible to travel with them.

Sewing Supplies: Please bring scissors for both cloth and paper, embroidery needles with large eyes, a small selection of embroidery thread colors, thimble. Bring a 9x12" sized piece of neutral colored wool felt (white or gray). Sewing machines optional if student is driving.

Notepad or Sketchbook and pen/pencil for note-taking **Dropcloths** Bring 2-3 large enough to cover work table surface
