STUDENT MATERIALS _Five day workshop

Required

A Water sprayer with adjustable nozzle

A Corrugated plastic boards (size: 20"x 30"- you can cut it in half for easy transportation and reconnect them with tape in class)

A Cylinder shaped/round wood dowel. (1" thickness and at least 24")- Dowels should be straight, curved ones will not work.

1 big Used towel (larger than the corrugated plastic boards)

A cheap flat paint brush (2-3" wide) and water bucket or container that fits the brush

Waterproof Apron or clothing that can be ruined by dyes A few Zip block sandwich bags Thin lab gloves if your hand is sensitive

Sketchbook or a few white copy papers / permanent markers

Couple of thin white large kitchen trash bags Scissor / Ruler

5 sheets of colored **100 percent mulberry papers** (size: prox. 24" x 36", medium thickness: 45gsm) - if you are having a hard time to find this, I will bring extra papers for you to purchase from me.(1 sheet is \$6) 1 tissue paper

Scraps of paper such as newspaper, rice paper, cotton, etc in various colors and texture- more is the merrier.

Various colored, textured, and thickness yarns and threads with a thick/big eye needle

Plastic forms for three dimensional shapes(if you cannot bring them, we can find something to use in class)

Awl/ paper punch

a roll of Bubble wraps (24" wide) cheap Packing tape

Optional:

Non-stick able to paper materials such as foil sheets, grocery bags, soft and bendable plastics / cutting board / acrylic paint and brush / sewing machine
