
Supply List:

Paper scissors

Clear Office Tape such as Scotch Magic Tape



12" Lightweight C-thru plastic grid ruler for measuring images on the computer screen *Note: the hard plastic rulers for rotary cutting are too stiff and can scratch the computer monitors.*



Flash drive for file transfer

Portable Hard Drive or cloud service such as Dropbox or Google Drive for storing your digital work

iPad or smartphone with working camera, or digital camera with USB card reader or cable
