Description

Join Pat Pauly to learn the quick steps to composing improvisationally - or improv - by building off pieces that start a design for an art quilt. With her handful of piecing techniques, and tips on construction, we will make mini-works that can be the finished art quilt or

become the base for larger work that begins a series. Let go of templates and see possibilities develop!

Supplies

Cutting mat at least 24" x 36"

Rotary cutter

Fabric scissors

Pins, seam ripper

Sewing machine with a regular foot, the usual sewing supplies

Fabrics

Fabrics should cover the full range of light, medium and dark.

Bring five one-gallon size storage bags of fabric scraps, none larger than 3" x 3".

Bring 5 to 10 fat quarters in a range of light to dark

Bring a quantity of yards, with a good range of light to dark. Try out some large scale prints if you have them, or some artist-made fabrics.
