## Supply List

A 7"x10" or 9"x12" sketchbook that will withstand wet media (e.g. india ink, paint, markers etc.). Canson Mix Media is a good option, but bring any brand you like.

A small bottle of black India ink and a cup for rinsing brushes

A variety of sizes of inexpensive brushes

Any art media you own that will make a mark (e.g. markers, crayons, charcoal, watercolors, etc.). Bring colors as well as black -- we will experiment with both.

Unusual mark-making objects (plastic fork, cotton swab, sponges, daubers, scrapers, etc.). Think outside of the box.

Phone, laptop or tablet with headphones (for private listening to music)

Camera (your phone's camera is fine)

One or two of your own photos to use as inspiration. These do not have to be printed. They can be saved on your phone.

For Stitching Exercises:

Solid black fabric

Crewel needles

Hand stitching thread. Your choice of color. Bring as many colors as you would like if you enjoy hand stitching.

Scissors, thimble, pins, etc.

Your choice of the following final projects:

1) For Composition:

Sewing machine & sewing kit with thread, scissors, pins etc

An extension cord and/or power strip

An extra light

A larger assortment of fabrics for composition

Rotary cutting supplies and mat

(Your composition could be fused instead. Bring appropriate supplies.)

2) For hand-stitched composition, or hand-stitched pattern exploration:

Solid fabric (any color you like) and a variety of threads

An extra light

A hand-sewing kit: scissors, needles, thimble, pins, etc.

3) For exploring machine quilting:

Prepared quilt sandwiches, using solid fabrics, for stitching

Sewing machine, darning or quilting foot, sewing kit, scissors, etc.

An extension cord and/or power strip

An extra light

A variety of machine quilting threads

4) For exploring machine embroidery:

Fabric to stitch on

Sewing machine, darning or quilting foot, sewing kit, scissors, etc.

Embroidery hoop to fit under your presser foot

An extension cord and/or power strip

An extra light

A variety of threads for machine sewing
