

Mark as Muse - 5 day class

Supply List

- A 9"x12" sketchbook/pad that will withstand wet media (e.g. india ink, paint, markers etc.). Canson XL Mix Media or Canson Watercolor Paper are good options, but bring any brand you like.
- A small bottle of black India ink and a cup for rinsing brushes.
- A variety of sizes of inexpensive brushes.
- Any art media you own that will make a mark (e.g. markers, crayons, charcoal, watercolors, etc.).
- Unusual mark-making objects (plastic fork, cotton swab, sponges, daubers, scrapers, etc.). Think outside of the box.
- Phone, laptop or tablet and headphones (for private listening to music).
- One or two of your own photos to use as inspiration. These do not have to be printed. They can be saved on your phone.
- Solid black and solid white fabric. At least two of each, around 12" square.
- Crewel embroidery needles.
- Hand stitching/embroidery thread. Your choice of color. Bring as many colors as you would like, but be sure to bring black, white and at least one color.
- Hand sewing kit – scissors, thimble, pins, etc.
- A white disappearing ink marker or light-colored pencil to draw onto black fabric.

Choose one of the following options for further exploration during the week:

1) Composition:

- Sewing machine & sewing kit with thread, scissors, pins, etc.
- An assortment of fabrics you might want to use in a larger composition.
- Rotary cutter, rulers (as desired), and mat.
- Your composition could be fused instead of pieced. Bring appropriate supplies – fusible, parchment paper, etc.
- An extension cord and/or power strip.
- An extra light.

2) Hand-stitched composition, or hand-stitched pattern exploration:

- Solid fabrics (any colors and sizes you like) and a variety of embroidery threads.
- A hand sewing kit: scissors, needles, thimble, pins, etc.
- An extra light.

3) Machine quilting:

- A minimum of six prepared quilt sandwiches for stitching, approximately 18” square, using solid fabrics. Bring extra if you are a fast worker.
- Sewing machine, darning or quilting foot, sewing kit, scissors, etc.
- Sewing machine extension table.
- A variety of machine quilting threads.
- An extension cord and/or power strip.
- An extra light.

4) Machine embroidery:

- At least six black or white fabric squares, approximately 15”.
- Sewing machine, darning or quilting foot, sewing kit, scissors, etc.
- Sewing machine extension table.
- Embroidery hoop to fit under your presser foot.
- An extension cord and/or power strip.
- An extra light.
- A variety of threads for machine sewing.
