

## Surface Design Shuffle (2-Day)

### Supply List

Fabrics: Choose any that you love! Consider using fabrics that are highly patterned and colored, specialty fabrics, one-of-a-kind printed fabrics, dyed fabrics, digitally-printed fabrics, etc. Include several options for a good color story – around 3 to 4 yards total – minimum size 12”x12”. We will discuss your options in class.

A color photo approximately 8.5"x11" size. It does not have to be those exact dimensions -- just anywhere close. This needs to not be precious to you as we will be cutting it up. A photo from an old calendar or a colorful photo from a magazine are good examples. Any image will work as long as it is colorful.

A glue stick and a couple of sheets of plain paper.

Rulers: A ruler that is 6” or 6.5” square is ideal. Any size square from 3.5” up to 12” will work however. You will also need a 6” or 6.5” x 24” for cutting strips.

A rotary cutter for cutting fabric, an old blade (or dedicated rotary cutter) for cutting paper, and cutting mat.

A piece of flannel or batting to use as a design wall and pins for pinning your design. A roll of blue painter’s tape to secure your design wall to the wall.

A camera -- this can be on your mobile phone.

Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies (thread, pins, scissors, etc.). Remember to include the foot pedal, power cord, extension cord and all accessories you will need for piecing. Bring along the machine manual just in case.
